About Sonne Küschnacht - Zürich

The Sonne in Küschnacht - Zurich is a boutique hotel with over 380 years of history, first mentioned in a Zurich document in 1641 as an inn. Located directly on the shores of Lake Zurich, the 4-star superior hotel comprises 40 individually designed rooms and junior suites. With three restaurants and a bar, this traditional establishment invites guests to enjoy home-style cooking, including the Sonnen-galerie, the Gaststuben, the Seegarten, and the Turmbar. Five event rooms and halls as well as an outdoor location provide the ideal setting for events such as seminars, meetings, or private functions. A fitness and wellness area with a sunbathing lawn and direct access to the lake, as well as leisure activities such as stand-up paddleboards and e-bikes, round off the offerings. The proximity to the city of Zurich and good public transport connections, including boat and train, offer a wide range of leisure activities both in the surrounding area and throughout Switzerland.
