Sonne Küsnacht on Lake Zurich is far more than a traditional 4 star superior hotel. It is a boutique hotel that brings together design elements and art. The publicly accessible areas of the hotel house a carefully curated collection of renowned works from the Swiss and international art scene. Art is not staged, but understood as a natural part of the house, entering into a quiet dialogue with the historic architecture and contemporary design.

The curatorial concept follows the principle of integration. Art and space interact with one another without one dominating the other. This creates unexpected sight-lines, inspiring contrasts and an aesthetic experience that blends organically into the guests' stay.

The collection includes works by internationally renowned artists such as Andy Warhol and Julian Schnabel, whose unmistakable styles set strong visual accents. The portfolio is complemented by important Swiss artists, including Augusto Giacometti, one of the pioneers of modern painting in Switzerland, as well as Alois Carigiet, whose work holds significant art historical importance far beyond his illustrations. A work by Meret Oppenheim, one of the most important representatives of Surrealism, is also part of the collection.

A distinctive feature of the collection is its accessibility. The artworks can be experienced freely in the lobby, the three restaurants, the bar and other public areas, without any sense of threshold or museum like distance. The works are deliberately left

unlabeled, allowing space for personal perception and individual interpretation. Upon request, interested guests or groups may take part in guided art talks or tours.

Sonne Küsnacht Zurich is a boutique hotel with over 380 years of history, first mentioned as an inn in a Zurich document in 1641. Located directly on the shores of Lake Zurich, the 4 star superior hotel offers 40 individually designed rooms and junior suites. With three restaurants and a bar, the historic property invites guests to enjoy traditional Swiss cuisine, including the Sonnengalerie, the Gaststube, the Seegarten and the Turmbar. Five event rooms and halls, as well as an outdoor location, provide the ideal setting for seminars, meetings or private events. A fitness and wellness area with a lawn and direct lake access, along with leisure activities such as stand up paddles and e bikes, complete the offering. The proximity to the city of Zurich and excellent public transport connections, including boat and train services, offer a wide range of leisure opportunities both in the surrounding area and throughout Switzerland.
