Sonne in Küschnacht Zurich: A boutique hotel that brings together history, hospitality and culinary enjoyment

Since 1641, the 4 star superior hotel has been welcoming guests from near and far. Located directly on the shores of Lake Zurich, the property combines centuries of history with warm hospitality and refined enjoyment. Its central location, just 13 minutes from Zurich city centre and 25 minutes from the airport, makes the boutique hotel with its lakeside restaurants an ideal retreat for travellers who value a personal atmosphere and individuality. Thanks to excellent public transport connections, including boat and train services, Sonne is easy to reach and offers the perfect starting point for exploring the region and the whole of Switzerland.

With 37 individually designed rooms and three junior suites, the hotel caters to a wide range of needs. The junior suites, measuring approximately 50 square metres, are located in the historic tower of the house and impress with views of Lake Zurich. Equipped with twin beds, a cosy seating area and Bang and Olufsen sound systems, they combine design and comfort. The spacious family rooms accommodate up to four guests and feature twin or queen size beds, a desk, a seating area and a sofa bed. Many of the rooms offer lake views and are spread between the main building and the lakeside house. Each room stands out through individually selected materials and distinctive stylistic details.

Guests can choose between three restaurants and a bar. At the Sonnengalerie restaurant, classic dishes and regional specialities are served alongside panoramic views of Lake Zurich. Art Deco elements and original artworks shape the restaurant's

atmosphere. The historic Gaststuben, open from October to May, offer Swiss cuisine paired with regional wines, complemented in winter by fondue chinoise. The Seegarten, open from April to October depending on the weather, invites hotel guests and day visitors to linger directly on the lake shore. The self service restaurant, located next to the Küschnacht boat landing stage, features a selection of dishes developed in collaboration with Michelin starred chef Heiko Nieder. The Turmbar, with its unique ship shaped bar counter, is the perfect place for an aperitif or to end the evening. From November to February, the hotel and the Seegarten are transformed into a winter landscape with an ice skating rink and an expanded culinary offering, complemented by festive decorations and lighting.

The 110 square metre fitness and wellness area includes a sauna, steam bath, ice grotto, Kneipp pool, relaxation room and a workout studio. With direct access to the lake and a sunbathing lawn, it becomes a place of retreat and relaxation, especially during the warmer months.

The leisure offering is complemented by the rental of stand up paddles and e bikes for exploring the surrounding area.

Sonne offers five versatile rooms and halls for banquets, seminars, meetings, private occasions or corporate celebrations, accommodating events of up to 160 guests. Each space impresses with its individual atmosphere: the magnificent ballroom of 190 square metres for large celebrations, banquets or weddings; the Turmsaal of 50 square metres and the Küschnachterstube of 40 square metres with historic charm for medium sized events or meetings; the cosy Guggenbühlstube of 24 square metres and the Prunkstube of 24 square metres for small, intimate occasions; as well as the lakeside meadow for outdoor events directly on Lake Zurich. An experienced three member event team supports guests with individual consultation, planning and implementation.

A propos de Sonne Küschnacht - Zürich

La Sonne Küschnacht Zurich est un boutique hôtel fort de plus de 380 ans d'histoire, mentionné pour la première fois en 1641 dans un document zurichois en tant qu'auberge. Situé directement sur les rives du lac de Zurich, l'hôtel 4 étoiles supérieur dispose de 40 chambres et junior suites aménagées individuellement. Avec trois restaurants et un bar, cette maison historique invite à découvrir une gastronomie traditionnelle, notamment la Sonnengalerie, les Gaststuben, le Seegarten et la Turmbar. Cinq salles et espaces événementiels, ainsi qu'un lieu en plein air, offrent le cadre idéal pour des séminaires, des réunions ou des événements privés. Un espace fitness et bien-être avec pelouse et accès direct au lac, ainsi que des activités de loisirs telles que des stand up paddles et des e bikes, complètent l'offre. La proximité de la ville de Zurich et l'excellente desserte par les transports publics, y compris le bateau et le train, offrent de nombreuses possibilités de loisirs, tant dans les environs que dans toute la Suisse.

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
